

STABAT MATER



Stabat Mater is the title of a 13th century Latin hymn meaning "the Mother was standing", describing the sorrow of Mary, the mother of Jesus, at the foot of the Cross.

It has been a source of inspiration for many composers, and we are performing the work of Italian composer Giovanni Battista Pergolesi, which he composed in 1736 in the final weeks of his life.

The work is divided into twelve movements and will accompany the Stations of the Cross.
